# Do It Anyway

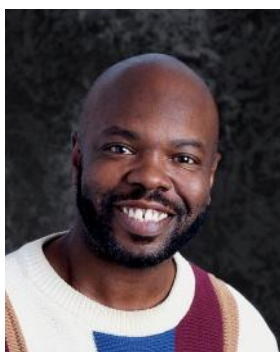
Mother Teresa

I doubted if I should ever come back.

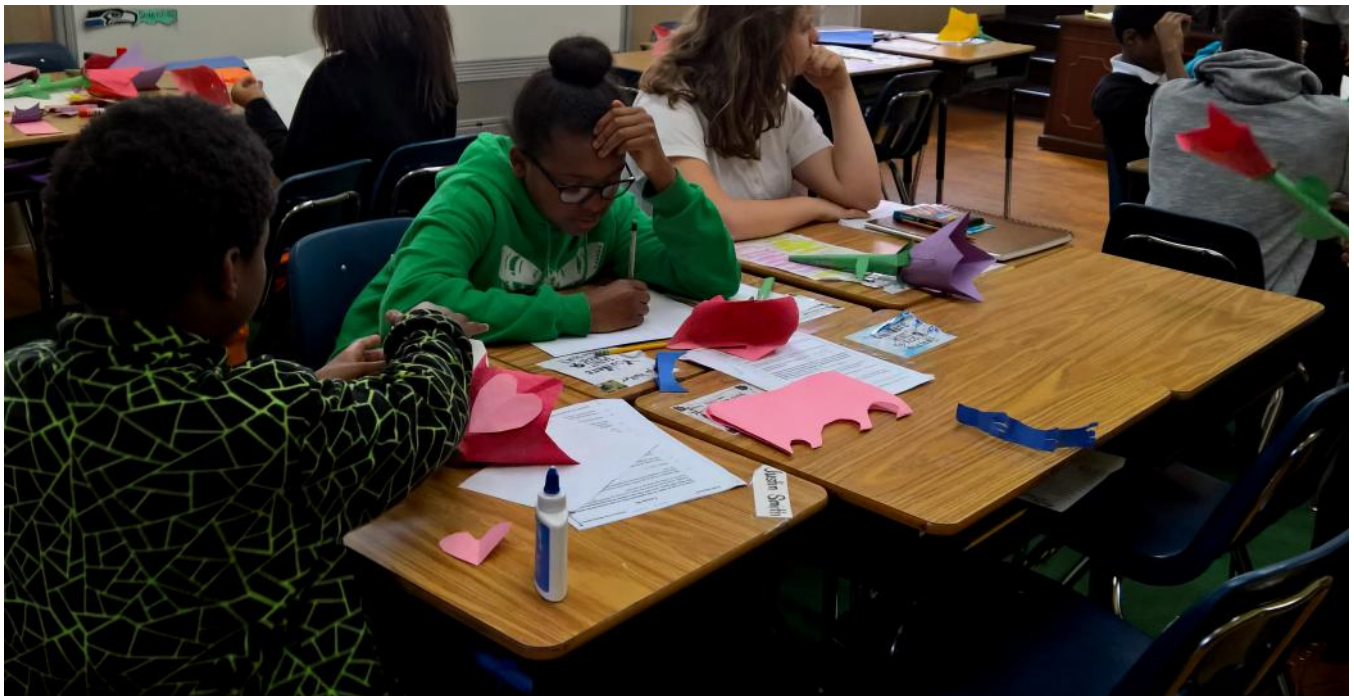
I shall be telling this with a sigh

And that has made all the difference.















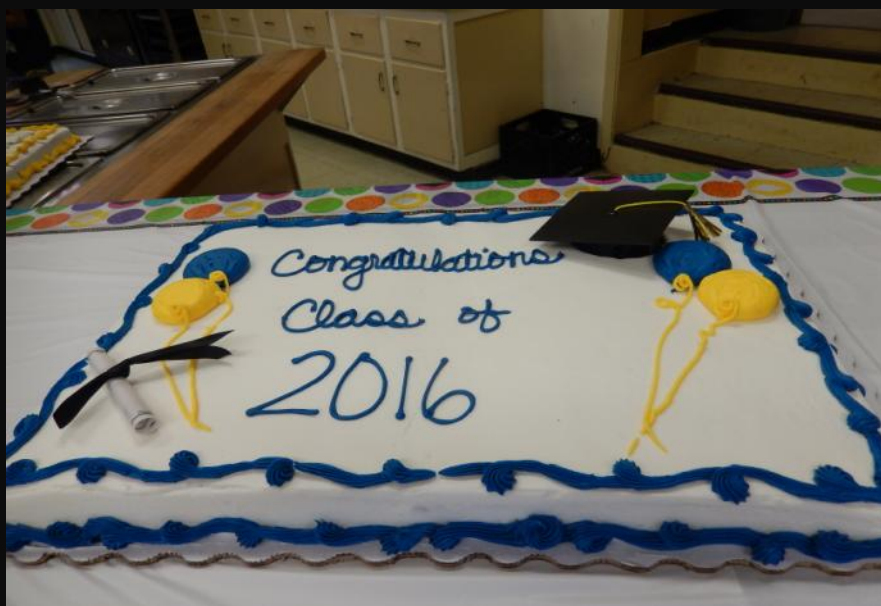
